






COMPARISON BOTTOM 10 (2020-2019)




- 
- Cambodia receives a **score of 21** on the CPI 2020
 - An improvement of one point compared to 2019
 - Cambodia now ranks **160th out of the 180 countries/territories included** in the Index
 - The country ranked **162/180** last year
 - Continues to occupy **the lowest spot in ASEAN and the third lowest in Asia Pacific Region**
 - Continues to be perceived as **highly corrupt**

CAMBODIA'S CPI SCORES COMPARISON OVER THE YEARS (2012 – 2020)









ASEAN COUNTRIES' CPI SCORES COMPARISON OVER THE YEARS



Key recommendations of TI Cambodia are:

1. Amend a number of articles in the Anti-Corruption Law, especially those concerning asset declaration
2. Adopt a law on access to information and a law that protects reporting persons, witnesses, experts and victims that meet international standards
3. Strengthen the institutions responsible for promoting the rule of law and address the gaps in the implementation of anti-corruption legislations
4. Enable active participation of CSOs, the media and citizens in the fight against corruption
5. Improve business environment and promote fair business competition by reducing bureaucratic burdens, promoting equal compliances and eliminate all forms of corruption which are the main barriers of doing business in Cambodia
6. Establish accountability mechanisms and ensure checks and balances at both the national and sub-national levels
7. Enhance effectiveness and independence of oversight institutions such as the parliament, the National Audit Authority, the Constitutional Council and the Anti-Corruption Unit
8. Promote transparency in revenue collection by providing public access to tax payer data to create a better playing field for the private sector and building public trust.
